

## Information for Contributors

The *International Journal of Epidemiology* is produced bimonthly and publishes original work, reviews and Letters to the Editor in the fields of research and teaching in epidemiology.

All papers are published in English although submission of articles in other languages will not prejudice editorial consideration. The author will be responsible for translation into English if the article is accepted for publication.

It is a condition of publication in the Journal that authors assign copyright to the International Epidemiological Association. This ensures that requests from third parties to reproduce articles are handled efficiently and consistently and will also allow the article to be as widely disseminated as possible. In assigning copyright, Authors may use their own material in other publications provided that the Journal is acknowledged as the original place of publication, and Oxford University Press is notified in writing and in advance.

Articles are accepted for publication on condition that they are contributed solely to the *International Journal of Epidemiology*. The editors cannot enter into correspondence about papers considered unsuitable for publication and their decision is final. Neither the editors nor the publishers accept responsibility for the views and statements of authors expressed in their contributions.

Authors of articles will be supplied with 50 free reprints.

Detailed instructions to authors are available on request from the editor or the publisher.

### Manuscripts

Papers should be submitted in *triplicate* to Professor P O D Pharoah, Department of Public Health, University of Liverpool, PO Box 147, Liverpool L69 3BX, UK.

Manuscripts should be prepared in the Vancouver Style (see e.g. *Br Med J* 1982; **284**: 1766–76) and should be less than 3000 words. The summary of the findings should form part of the manuscript.

References should be in the order made in the text and numbered accordingly. These numbers should be inserted above the line on each occasion a reference is cited (... confirmed by other studies<sup>23</sup>). Numbered references should appear at the end of the article and should consist of the surnames and initials of *all* authors when six or less, when seven or more list the first three and add *et al.*, title of article, name of journal abbreviated according to *Index Medicus* style, year, volume, first and last page numbers, e.g. Bull Q, Doe J. Epidemiology and public health. *Int J Epidemiol* 1970; **5**: 702–10. For books, names and initials of all authors, the full title, place of publication, publisher, year of publication and page number should be given.

All measures should be reported in SI units followed, in text, by traditional units in parentheses. For general guidance on the International System of Units and some useful conversion factors, see '*The SI for the Health Professions*' (WHO, 1977). There are two exceptions; blood pressure should be expressed in mm Hg and haemoglobin as g/dl.

### Illustrations

Illustrations should be numbered, given suitable legends and marked lightly on the back with the author's name and the top edge indicated. Original drawings may be submitted although high quality glossy photographs are preferable. Illustrations and tables should be kept separate from the text.

### Review of Books

Books and monographs will be reviewed as space permits and may be sent to the Editor.
